All instructions and suggestions in this document are given for guidance only and the installer should satisfy themselves that their planned deck will be safe given their individual circumstances and requirements.



















MADE IN

Installation

- Always use treated timber to maximise the life of the sub-frame.
- •Bearers should be C16 grade timber of a nominal size  $2'' \times 6''$  (45mm x 145mm). The notes below apply to this specification.

- •Generally bearers run with the line of most traffic so that the decking boards run across the line. This must be observed with ramps, walkways and steps.
- Do not exceed maximum centres between bearers of 450mm for normal domestic loads. Centres of 400mm are recommended
- ${}^{\bullet}\text{A}$  support leg should be installed at maximum every 2.4m along the bearer.
- •Install a minimum of one line of noggins across the centre of every span up to 2.4m. Larger spans should have noggins every 1200mm (max). Inserting more lines of noggins creates greater rigidity and strength.
- Always offset joints between longer lengths of decking by at least 2 bearers (900mm).
- Always ensure adequate through ventilation beneath the deck, especially when using darker deck colours.




DekBoard Arena boards are practical, tough and durable. If you want a decking area that can take on all comers, then Arena is a great choice.

# **HORIZON**

**A TRADITIONAL BALUSTRADE SYSTEM THAT WILL COMPLEMENT PROMENADE** OR ARENA DECKS.

It is important to have a balustrade in order to keep children safe and avoid falls in general.

DekBoard Horizon balustrades can be made up in a number of ways using traditional top and bottom rails with pickets in square or diamond format, or with glass panels instead.

The hand rail and bottom rails should be reinforced with a metal insert that makes them very rigid and therefore able to take a lot of pressure from the side or above.

Glass panels are becoming popular and the Horizon range provides for clear and tinted toughened glass versions which can be mounted to your deck in a number of ways.

Please consult the section on balustrade height to determine the right height for your installation.

### **POSTS**


- Always use a timber infill for posts of at least 95 x 95mm. Post infills may also be made up of  $2 \times 45$ mm  $\times 95$ mm sections screwed together.
- Where the post is to be secured into a concrete or substantial timber base a post insert (DPOSTM) may be used (p7)
- Timber post infills should be set into concrete or mounted on to well set and well drained concrete or stone pads.
- Always treat the exposed end grain of such posts for long term protection.
- Remember to slide the post cover over the timber post infills prior to fixing the deck sub-frame to the posts.
- Bearers may be screwed directly to posts or affixed using a Sub-Frame Bracket (p7)



### **Post Mount**

Mark the location of the corner holes on the lower mounting plate and drill a 10mm hole into the substrate for each of the 4 corners in order to accept a suitable M8 Fixing Anchor or appropriate concrete screws.


Set up the correct angle for the Post Insert by adjusting the 4 bolts threaded through the upper mounting bracket. Insert the anchors through the corner holes of both plates on the Post mount as shown and press them into the substrate.

Once the final adjustment of the post position has been achieved ensure the anchors are bolted down and the lock nuts on the adjusting bolts are tightened up against the underside of the upper mounting plate.

### Sub Frame Bracket



This bracket is used to secure the open corners of a sub-frame to a corner post.

The deck must be supported by bearers and a deck clip used on each bearer at maximum centres of 450mm. Deck clips should be secured using 4.5mm x 30mm Stainless Steel counter sunk screws (Code - DWSCREW30). Where decking boards are not set at 90deg to the bearers the fixing centres of the decking board will naturally increase. This should be accounted for in bearer spacing in that area.

### **HEIGHT OF BALUSTRADES**

Balustrades on decks can serve several functions, ranging from simple decorative boundaries to full safety barriers.


Even a small change of level can be a hazard, particularly for elderly or infirm users. Unless the deck surface is flush with the surrounding ground, a balustrade should be incorporated.

The height of the balustrade depends on how far the deck surface is off the ground:

For 'low-level' structures where the deck surface is up to 600mm from ground level, the hand rail height should be a minimum of 900mm above the deck surface.

For 'high-level' decks over 600mm high the balustrade height should be a minimum of 1100mm above the deck surface.

DekBoard standard balustrade components have been designed to meet the requirements for low-level structures. For high level structures the picket height should be increased to at least 960mm.

### Note -

• Fix the lower section of each bottom bracket in position first, ensuring that they are level. Pre-assemble the rails, reinforcing bar, and pickets (see p9-10), set them into the bottom rail brackets and mark the position for the top rail brackets. Remove the rail assembly,

fix the top rail brackets in place and reinstall the rail assembly. The top sections of each bracket simply clip into place. A screw must be fixed into the hole in the bottom of the bracket.

 Always check that the top brackets are fixed at the required balustrade height





# 6" Picket for Skirting

The Facing/Skirting Board is used for facing off the edge of the deck in order to hide the timber bearers. The boards can be secretly fixed from behind using 60mm woodscrew DWSCREW60 (p7) assuming that the timber substructure is at least 40mm deep. In addition it can be mounted vertically or horizontally under the deck to form a screen or skirt that hides the full deck substructure. Always leave gaps between boards for ventilation.



# DEKBOARD GLASS

Toughened glass is up to five times stronger than regular glass. This is achieved by heating at high temperatures and cooling very quickly.

Toughened laminated glass has a plastic interlayer between 2 panes of glass holding them together. If one of the toughened glass panes does happen to break not only will there be no falling glass particles but the additional toughened glass pane and the interlayer will provide an extra barrier to prevent injury.

# **GATES**


We recommend that a gate is fitted to all raised deck platforms. With self-closing hinges and lockable latches these gates provide a safe enclosure for children and a deterrent to others.



The holes can be routed square with the rail or at 45° to the rail to form a diamond shape.

# DEKBOARD PLAN YOUR DECK

Use this handy space to plan your perfect deck. Start by drawing the area you'd like to deck out, and then work out the number of boards required.

Our board length is 4902mm and the width is 145mm. Each board has a 5mm gap between it and the next board (this gap is created by the decking clips), so the cover width is 150mm. Therefore, each board covers 0.735 of a square metre (ie approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  sqm).

To work out the number of boards that are required just calculate the number of square metres your deck will cover, then divide that number by 0.735

### Example:

A deck of  $5m \times 4m$  has an area of 20sqm. The number of boards needed is  $20 \div 0.735 = 27.2$  boards. You should also allow 12 to 14 decking clips per decking board.


Important – This calculation is an approximate guide. Very few decks are nicely rectangular and so you'll have to allow for odd areas that may require you to cut the boards in ways that create more wastage than this simple calculation allows for. Therefore you should allow for at least 10% wastage. In some circumstances it may be helpful to tailor the size of your deck to make the most of each board length.

Remember that the following basic principles of setting out the boards may affect the number of boards you'll need to use:

Run the boards across the most common line of tread, not with it.

Separate all joints on adjacent boards by at least 2 bearers

All deck pieces should be long enough to be secured to at least 3 bearers.


